

- Children of Israel had just crossed the Red Sea on dry land.
- The Egyptians had pursued them and pinned them against the Red Sea.
- Clearly in a perilous predicament, they were very concerned and feared the absolute worst.
- Appeared their fate was sealed, and many thought, "Life is over!"
- But Moses told them that the Egyptians that pursued them they would see no more forever. **Exodus 14:13**

II. The Challenges

Romans 5:1-4

- We learn more about ourselves in times of difficulty and strife than we do in moments of ease and comfort.
- Learn more when we have challenges, and things do not go as we planned or would have liked.
 - Performers always learn more after a loss than a victory
 - Learn what we need to improve upon.
 - Good coaches want there to be moments of difficulty and struggle to continue the learning process and growth

- Challenges build character and strength. You can either be comfortable and stagnate or stretch yourself—become uncomfortable—and grow. Choose the latter.
- We learn who are true friends and those we can depend on.
- A friend loves at all times, and a brother is born for adversity. Proverbs 17:17

III. DAILY PROVISION

GOD has always provided for his own.

I have been young, and now am old; yet I have not seen the righteous forsaken, nor his descendants begging bread.

Psalms 37:25

- •Often though, God does not work on our time and in the way(s) we think He should.
- •God's people left Egypt with material blessings, but what was the source?

Now the children of Israel had done according to the word of Moses, and they had asked from the Egyptians articles of silver, articles of gold, and clothing. And the LORD had given the people favor in the sight of the Egyptians, so that they granted them what they requested. Thus they plundered the Egyptians. **Exodus 12:35-36**
