ANATOMY OF A TERRIBLE DECISION Mark 15:1-15

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BACKDROP

- Today's message covers the sham trial and sentencing of the Lord after He had been:
 - betrayed by Judas (Mark 14:10-11, 43-46);
 - forsaken by his "closest friends" (Mark 14:50); and
 - denied by Peter (Mark 14:66-72).

BACKDROP

- Jesus goes from halls of Pilate to the cross in just a few hours.
- Sometimes we keep individuals on death row for decades.
- Pilate had a choice to make.
- In a convenient season of appealing to the masses, he clearly made the wrong decision – a very poor choice.
 Barabbas over the Lord of Glory

When presented with various options, I have always been instructed to "CHOOSE WISELY" and "MAKE GOOD DECISIONS".

WHY → Because the trajectory and quality of our lives and the lives of others (wife, children, business associates, etc.) may very well hang in the balance!!

Many times, we may incur huge opportunity costs when making decisions.

Opportunity cost?

Making a choice renders the selection (opportunity) of any other course unavailable (cost).

AT THE CORE OF PILATE'S TERRIBLE DECISION

- 1. ENVY
- 2. "POT STIRRING"

- 3. CROWD PLEASING
- 4. FEAR

1. DISCARD ENVY (Mark 15:8–10)

Then the multitude, crying aloud, began to ask him to do what he had always done for them. But Pilate answered them, saying, "Do you want me to release to you the King of the Jews?" For he knew that the chief priests had handed Him over because of envy.

- Envy clouds judgment and forces one to make irrational and irresponsible decisions.
- Instead of pursuing mercy, justice and humility, the focus is destruction.

2. STAY AWAY FROM POT STIRRERS (Mark 15:11)

But the chief priests stirred up the crowd, so that he should rather release Barabbas to them. Life is littered with people who do nothing but cause dissension
 Their chief aim is to put people on edge and increase strife and division

 Such persons destroy unity
 These six things does the Lord hate, yes seven are an abomination to Him
 ... One who sows discord among brethren. Proverbs 6:16, 19 3. DON'T BE A CROWD PLEASER (Mark 15:15)

So Pilate, wanting to gratify the crowd, released Barabbas to them; and he delivered Jesus, after he had scourged Him, to be crucified.

Crowd pleasers tend to be followers

- World is littered with followers
- Do something grand break from the herd and excel!
- They are the ones who are remembered.



TWO-FOLD PURPOSE OF BOUNDARIES

Insulation

- Protection from external forces

Restraint

- Mechanism for internal controls
- Protection from self puts a governor on our own passions

- Before hanging out or dating
 - Establish activities to engage in
 - Determine places to go
- Prior to going to the mall
 - Set spending limits

- In advance of choosing a mate
 - Envision the type person with whom you want to spend the rest of your life.
